

TRASH CANS need to be pulled up and behind a wall barrier immediately after trash pickup. Trash goes out every Tuesday. Recycle bi-weekly. Bulk pickup is every 1st Wednesday of the month.

PETS need to be pick up after and they must be leashed while walking.

CARS must **NOT** be parked in streets or pool parking lot overnight. Contact HOA for special limited time exemption. Curbside parking is illegal while facing **ON-COMING** traffic by state law.

MIND THE POOL RULES PLEASE:

For full Pool Policies visit www.banfortfarmswest.com (Tabs: Documentation - Governance)

- 1. NO LIFE GUARD ON DUTY: For safety reasons children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult. Teenage residents (16yrs to 18yrs) may only have a single guest that is also 16+ years old.
- 2. **Normal Hours** are from 10am to 10pm. **Adult Only Swim** 6am to 10am daily. An adult is considered to be 18+ years of age.
- 3. **Pool Key Replacement** is \$40. Please contact the HOA for reactivations and replacements. (Limit 1 proximity key card per household)
- 3. **Cameras** are installed and monitored for our safety. Please report any violations / incidents to the HOA ASAP.
- 5. **Resident to Visitor** ratio is 6 visitor per household and must be accompanied by the resident. Seven or more guest is considered a "party" and requires approval and deposit.
- 6. **Pool Parties** are limited to 20 guests (not including immediate resident family members). Hours are limited to 2.5 hours and not to exceed 9pm. Fees and other information can be found in the policy online at above link.
